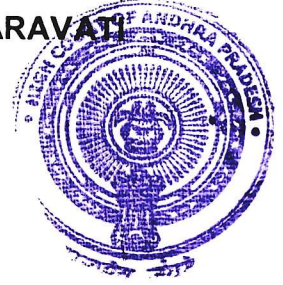

The disputed cheque is drawn on SBH, which was amalgamated with SBI with effect from 01.04.2017, as submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in S.T.C.No.58 of 2024 on the file of the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kadapa, until the next date of hearing.
