Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in seeking to dispossess the petitioners from the possession of the property, situated in the sy.no. 18/1, compromising the building bearing Municipal. D.No. 21/442, situated in ward no. 21, admeasuring 34 ft. from east to west and 26 ft. from north to south, equivalent to 114.08 Sq. at Kadapa town purchased under registered sale deeds respectively Dt.1.3.2019 is illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, ultra vires, Violaive Article 14, 21 and 300A of Constitution of India and without any authority or sanction of law and consequently direct the respondent to resist from interfering with the possession, enjoyment of the property by the petitioners.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere with the possession of the property of the petitioners situated in Sy. No. 18/1, comprising of the building bearing Municipal D.No. 21/442, situated in ward no. 21, admeasuring 34 ft. From east to west and 26 ft. From north to south, equivalent to 114.08 Sq. Yrds Kadapa Town pending disposal of WP 15704 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

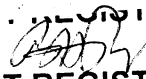
