WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri Venkateswarlu Kolla, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 3rd Respondent in issuing vide Proceedings No.01/122(02)/2023-RCTY, dt.30.06.2023, in giving outsourcing contract to the 5th respondent on nomination basis for Sweeping, Cleaning of Garage, Maintenance of Toilets at 4th respondent Depot with retrospective effect from 10.04.2023 to 09.10.2023 or until finalisation of tenders whichever is earlier, is illegal, arbitrary and violation of Principles of Natural Justice and consequently direct the respondents to continue the Petitioner in this regard;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Venkateswarlu Kolla, Advocate for the Petitioner, learned GP FOR TRANSPORT for respondent No.1 and Sri K.
