

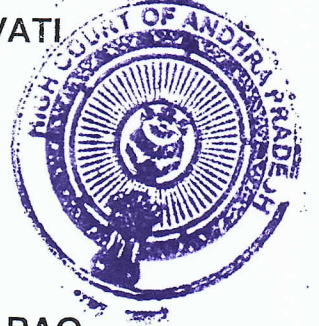

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the Impugned order passed by the 2nd respondent vide Roc.No.482/2024/Coord/D8, dt. 15-05-2025 to decide the Civil dispute between the petitioner and 5th respondent and also claim of the 5th respondent is barred by limitation and in not complying the other statutory provisions of the sale deed under Transfer of the Property Act is illegal,

arbitrary, colorable exercise without jurisdiction and in violation of principles of natural justice and consequently set-aside the same.
