WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. M.S.BANU PRASAD RAO, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of respondent no. 2 to 4 in entering the unofficial respondents in online adangal without putting the petitioner on notice with regard to land admeasuring in an extent of Ac 1.79 Cents in Sy. No. 94/2 situated in Yerragondapallem Village and Mandal, Prakasam District without following the due process of law and the as illegal arbitrary and contrary to the Andhra Pradesh Rights in land and pattadhar passbook act, 1971 apart from being violative of fundamental and constitutional rights guaranteed to the petitioner under Article 14,19, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently, direct the respondents 2 to 4 to restore the entries for the land in an extent of Ac 1.79 Cents in Sy. No. 94/2 situated in Yerragondapallem Village and Mandal, Prakasam District in his favour;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M.S.BANU PRASAD RAO, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP FOR REVENUE, for the Respondent Nos.1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.5 & 6, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
