WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI P NAGENDRA REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent.No.5 for not conducting proper enquiry and investigated against the petitioner in PRC 36 of 2017 in Crime No.26 of
