Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or direction declaring the action of the respondents withholding entire pension, entire gratuity, Dearness allowance, Pay Revision Commission benefits and all retirement benefits on account of pending one vigilance report proceedings vide vig. Report No. 30 C.No.1391/VandE/D4/2009 dt.- 24-03-2015, without taking into consideration my representation dt.- 15-04-2021 05-05-2021, 19-04-2022, 09-05-2022, as highly illegal, irregular, irrational, without jurisdiction arbitrary violation of principles of natural justice and Article 14, 21 and 300-A of the constitution of India and consequently to directing the respondents to pay the full pension, entire gratuity, Dearness allowance, Pay Revision Commission and all retirement benefits along with interest from the date of retirement to till the payment.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to deposit the monthly pension and gratuity, Dearness allowance, Pay Revision Commission along with interest from the date of retirement till the date of payment pending disposal of the main writ petition and pass, Pending disposal of WP 22715 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of PAVAN KUMAR PASUPULETI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR WOMEN & CHILD WELFARE for the Respondent No.s 1 & 2, GP FOR FINANCE for the Respondent No.s 3 & 4 and the Court made the following.

ORDER

"It is represented by learned Government Pleader that pensionary amounts were already released and paid to the petitioner and to that effect he has filed verification report dated 15.07.2022 issued by the Office of the Accountant General (A&E) Andhra Pradesh, Amaravathi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to get instructions whether the amounts are received or not.

Post the matter on 15.11.2022."
