Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondents in seeking to dispossess the petitioners from the lands over an extent of an extent of Ac 1.47 cts in Sy.No.36/3 and Ac 0.87 cts in Sy.No.36/6 situated at Gundala Village, Yetapaka Mandal, Alluri Sitha Rama Raju District without following the due process of law as wholly illegal, arbitrary and consequently direct the 3rd respondent not to interfere with the possession of the petitioners in respect of the above mentioned landed property in the interest of justice.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 3rd respondent and his sub ordinates not to interfere and dispossess the petitioners from the lands over an extent of Ac 1.47 cts in Sy.No.36/3 and Ac 0.87 cts in Sy.No.36/6 situated at Gundala Village, Yetapaka Mandal, Alluri Sitha Rama Raju District pending disposal of WP 17104 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s. K.Venkatesh, Advocate for the Petitioners and of GP for Revenue for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and the Court made the following
