The petitions coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petitions and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M.R.K.Chakravarthy, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of Sri Rambabu Koppineedi, Advocate for the Petitioners and of GP FOR HIGHER EDUCATION for Respondent Nos. 1 and 4 and of Sri Vivekananda Virupaksha, Advocate for Respondent No.2, the Court made the following0

ORDER:

“Heard Sri M.R.K. Chakravarthy, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of Sri Rambabu Koppineedi, learned Counsel for the Writ Petitioners, Sri G. Ramachandra Rao, learned Government Pleader for Higher Education and Sri Vivekananda Virupaksha, learned Standing Counsel for the Respondent No.2.

2. Learned Counsel for the Writ Petitioners has drawn the attention of this Court to the Order passed by this Court in W.P.No.11106 of 2025 dated 09.05.2025.
