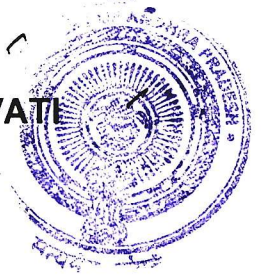

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri.VENKATESHWARLU GUMMADEVELLY presented this Petition under

Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or order or direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of mandamus declaring proceedings No. NCC(AP)/920/25/Estt/A-2, dt.29.10.2020 issued by the 1st respondent as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Article 14 and 16 of constitution of India and set aside the same with a consequential direction to the respondents to declare the probation of the petitioner the cadre of Typist duly releasing annual grade increments with all consequential benefits without reference to pendency of W.P.10749/2019
