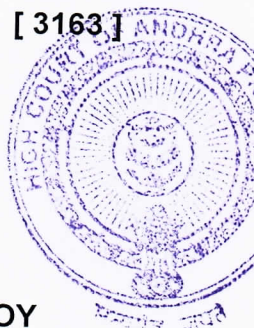

WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri G V S Kishore Kumar presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an Order, direction, proceedings or Writ more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Certiorari to call for the records in FIR No.507/2021, Dt.15.06.2021 before Bommuru Police Station, Rajamahendravaram (Urban), East Godavari District, before the 4th respondent and to quash the same (b) That this Hon'ble Court may direct the 3rd Respondent to transfer the case to any other police station, other than, the jurisdiction of the 4th respondent officer for the purpose of investigation, if any, c) That this Hon'ble Court may direct Respondents to continue with enquiry/investigation, if there is any requirement to do so, under the strict supervision of the Principal District Judge, East Godavari District or in the alternative under the supervision of a Hon'ble District Judge, equivalent cadre to Principal District Judge, East Godavari District, d) direct the Respondents to pay compensation of reasonable amount for intimidating mental harassment and threats meted out to the Writ Petitioners.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri G V S Kishore Kumar Advocate for the Petitioners, and GP for Home for Respondent Nos 1 to 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondents Nos 4 to 6 herein returnable in four (04) weeks to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

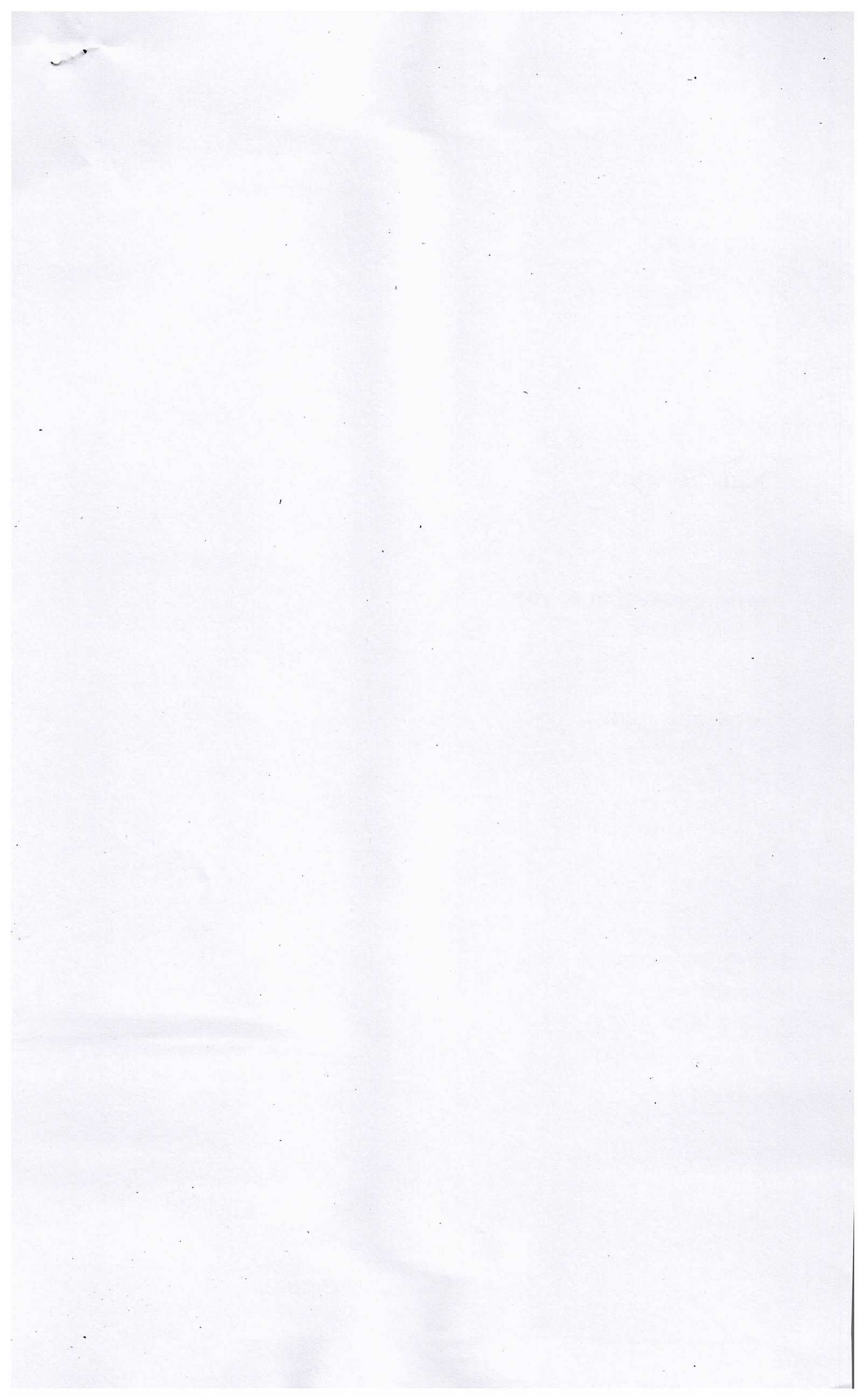
