Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 3rd respondents issuing Proceedings Rc. No. SSA-16021/54/2023-SEC-CMO SS

Dated. 30-07-2024 purporting to have been issued as per the Government Memo No. 977203/Prog.II/A2/2019-8 dated. 30-07-2024 directing all the District Educational Officers and Additional Project Co-Ordinators in the state to conduct elections on 08-08-2024 to the School Management Committees by issuing the schedule and to take-necessary action and issued certain guidelines in conducting elections to the private aided School and thereby changing the nomenclature of the petitioner's school is highly illegal, arbitrary, Violating Article 14,19, and 30(1) of the constitution of India and Contravention of the A.P. Education Act., 1982, consequently set aside the same.
