Petition under Section 430(1) of BNSS., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the sentence and conviction imposed against the petitioner/accused passed by the dated 12.06.2026 in S.C.No. 16/2023 On the file of the Special Court for speedy trial of offences under the protection of children from sexual offences act (POCSO Act) Guntur, by granting bail to the Petitioner/Appellant, pending disposal of the above criminal appeal pending disposal of the above criminal appeal;

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard Mr.Bhaskar Prem Koushik, learned counsel representing Mr.Ganta Ediga Rakesh Goud, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Mr.G.Neelothpal, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, appearing for the State/respondent No.1.

Considering the grounds raised in the appeal and also the judgment, which is now in question in S.C.No.16 of 2023, dated 12.06.2026, since the punishment imposed on the accused is three years and considering the nature of offence, and also the statement that fine imposed is also paid, this Court is of the view that the petitioner/accused be released on bail.

Accordingly, the sentence of imprisonment imposed on the petitioner/accused by the learned Special Court for Speedy Trial of Offences under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO Act), Guntur, in Sessions Case No.16 of 2023 alone is suspended, pending disposal of the Criminal Appeal, and the petitioner herein shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Court for Speedy Trial of Offences under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO Act), Guntur.
