Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent Nos. 4 to 7 not to call upon the petitioner to the police stations under the guise of investigation in connection with FIR No.363 of 2019 pending on the file of Mutyalareddypalli Police Station, Tirupathi Urban District, FIR No.19 of 2020 pending on the file of S.V.U Campus Police Station, Tirupathi Urban District, FIR No. 386 of 2020 pending on the file of Tirupathi East Police Station, Tirupathi Urban District, FIR No. 26 of 2021 pending on the file of Tirupathi East Police Station, Tirupathi Urban District, FIR No. 305 of 2021 pending on the file of Tiruchanur Police Station, Tirupathi Urban District and FIR No. 599 of 2021 pending on the file of Tirupathi East Police Station, Tirupathi Urban District, pending disposal of WP No.21908 of 2021, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI N SRIHARI Advocate for

the Petitioner and of GP FOR HOME for the Respondents 1 to 7, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“The petitioner prays to direct the Police officials, who are respondents 4 to 7, not to call the petitioner to the police station in connection with the crimes that were registered against him pending disposal of the writ petition.

Admittedly various crimes were registered against the petitioner in various police stations for various offences. Therefore, the law has to take its own course in all the said crimes that were registered against the petitioner. No blanket order directing the Police officials not to summon the petitioner in connection with the investigation of the said cases can be issued.

However, it is stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the Police officials are regularly calling the petitioner to the police station every day and making him to sit idle from morning to evening and that the petitioner is being subjected to much hardship on account of the said acts of the Police officials. Even though crimes were registered against the petitioner and the investigation in these cases is pending, Police officials cannot summon the petitioner to the police station daily and make him to sit idle from morning to evening in the guise of investigation of the said cases.

Therefore, in the said facts and circumstances of the case, respondents 4 to 7 are directed not to call the petitioner to the police station every day and making him to sit idle from morning to evening in the police station, till the next date of hearing. However, it is made clear that as and when the presence of the petitioner is required for the purpose of investigation of the said cases, respondents 4 to 7 are at liberty to summon the petitioner to the police station in connection with the investigation of the said cases.”

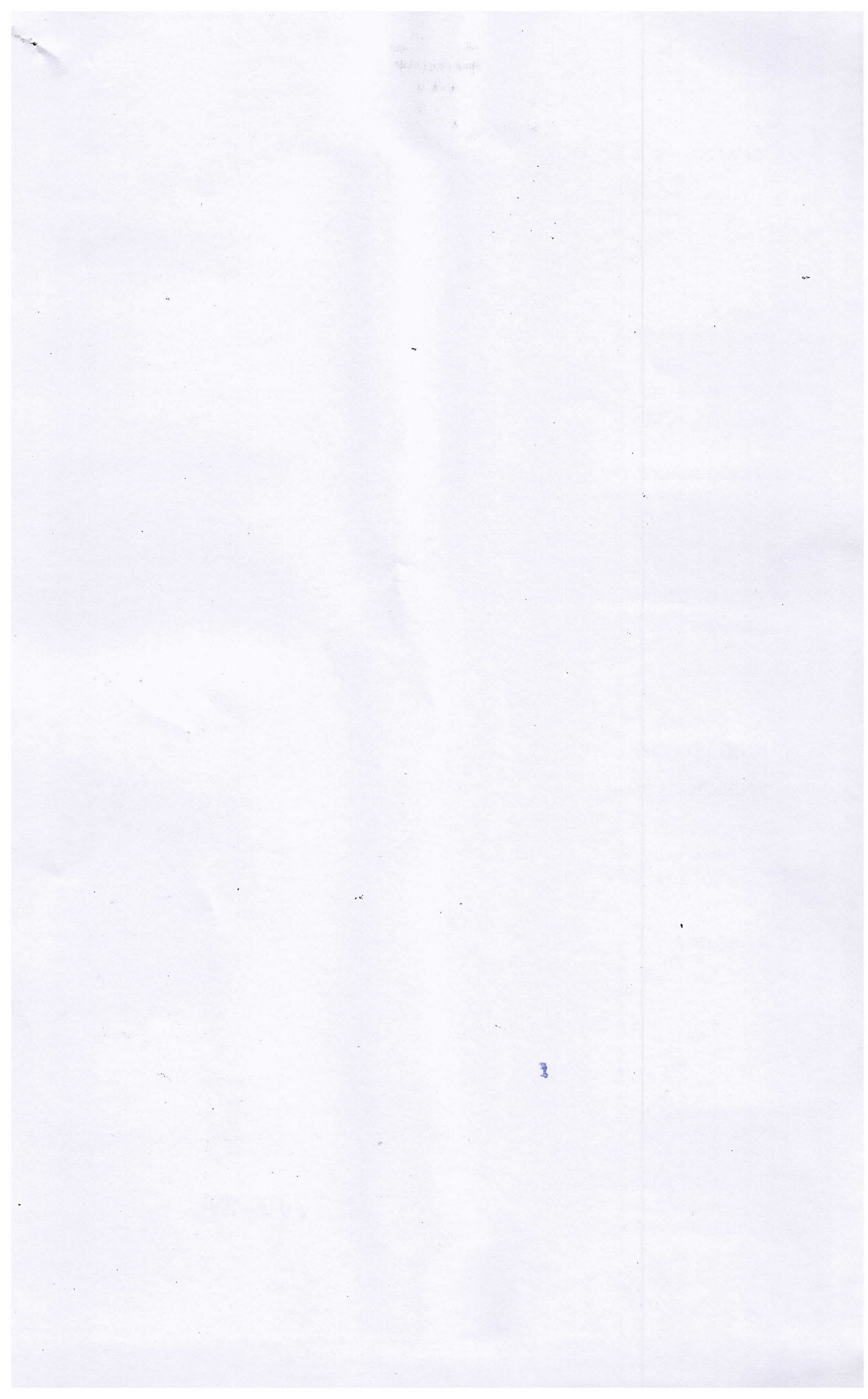
