circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be  
pleased to issue a Writ Order or direction particularly, one in the nature of writ  
of Mandamus declaring the action of 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in  
making efforts to dispossess from the land admeasuring an extent of  
Ac. 0.01  $\frac{3}{4}$  cents in Survey No. 857/3D situated at Madakalavaripalle Village,  
Gopavaram Mandal, Badvel Sub-Division, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra  
Pradesh without having any right over the property and without following  
procedure established by the law as illegal, arbitrary and violation of principles

of natural justice and consequently direct the respondents not to dispossess the petitioner from the subject property of an extent Ac. 0.01  $\frac{3}{4}$  cents in Survey No. 857/3D situated at Madakalavaripalle Village, Gopavaram Mandal, Badvel Sub-Division, YSR Kadapa District Andhra Pradesh, except due process of law;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere into the peaceful possession of the subject property of an extent Ac. 0.01  $\frac{3}{4}$  cents in Survey No. 857/3D situated at Madakalavaripalle Village, Gopavaram Mandal, Badvel Sub-Division, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh, except due process of law, Pending disposal of WP 19348 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
