“to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of the respondents in considering the representation of the petitioner dt.01-11-2012 to take action against the Respondent No.7 for his illegal interference with quarry lease granted to the petitioner by the 5th respondent in Proc.No.36516/R5-1/2006, dt.31-12-2009 and work orders issued by the 6th respondent in Proc.No.3937/Q/2006, dt.27-01-2010 as arbitrary, illegal, unjust and unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents 5 & 6 not to insist upon the petitioner to pay the Advance Dead Rent for the year 2015-16 pursuant to Notice No.2077/R5-1/2015, dt.19-01-2016 and pass”

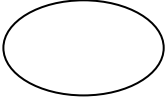
