The Court made the following:**ORDER:**

Aggrieved by the non disposal of I.A.No.627 of 2022 in O.S.No.215 of 2022 pending on the file of the Court of the Principal Junior Civil Judge, at Badvel, YSR Kadapa District, the present Civil Revision Petition is filed.

2. Heard Sri Mohammad Ghalib Shahid, learned counsel for the petitioner. Despite service of notice, none appeared for the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that I.A.No.627 of 2022 in O.S.No.215 of 2022 has been filed on the file of the Principal Junior Civil Judge, Badvel, YSR Kadapa, duly praying the Court to grant temporary injunction restraining the respondents and their men from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit land. He further contended that the present Civil Revision Petition can be disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to dispose of the I.A.No.627 of 2022 in a time bound manner.

4. Taking the submissions into consideration, as the relief sought is innocuous, this Court is inclined to dispose of this Civil Revision Petition by passing the following order:

“The trial Court is directed to dispose of the I.A.No.627 of 2022 in O.S.No.215 of 2022 as expeditiously as possible within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Accordingly, the Civil Revision Petition is ***disposed of***. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
