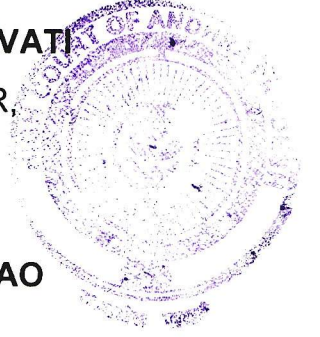

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the memorandum of grounds filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 03.02.2011 & 08.07.2025 made herein and the arguments of Sri Aravala Rama Rao, Advocate for the Petitioners and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent, the Court made the following;
