The Court made the following order:

The petitioner originally filed O.A.No.1281 of 2017 on the file of learned Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal, at Hyderabad (for short 'the Tribunal') to declare the action of the 3rd respondent in considering the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Deputy Tahsildar while promoting his juniors, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. After the abolition of the Tribunal, the O.A. was transferred to High Court and the same is numbered as W.P.(APAT).No.816 of 2021.

3. The writ petition was listed on 23.01.2026, however, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and at the request of the learned Assistant Government Pleader. The writ petition was directed to be listed on 06.02.2026. On 06.02.2026, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner. The writ petition was directed to be listed on 13.02.2026, under the caption "for dismissal". Even on 13.02.2026, there was no representation for the petitioner. To give one more opportunity, the writ petition was adjourned to today.

4. Even today, there is no representation for the petitioner. It seems the petitioner is not interested in prosecuting the writ petition.

5. Hence, this Writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. No costs.
