Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the 7th respondent by 'RPAD' and file proof of service in the Registry. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is the absolute owner and possessor of the land in an extent of Ac.0.60 cents in R.S.No.747-2, 747-1 and 748-2 of Peda Kapavaram Village, Akividu Mandal, West Godavari District, by virtue of registered sale deed dated 19.02.2022. Adjacent to the said land, there is 60 feet main road passing through R.S.No.747-4 as per the village field survey report. Now the respondents 1 to 3 constructed a Balasadan in the Government land and are high-handedly closing the 60 feet road, which is available to the petitioner for ingress and egress to petitioner's lands by enclosing the Balasadan by barbed wire fencing, thereby preventing the petitioner's ingress and egress to his lands, which is illegal and arbitrary.	

		Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, submissions of the learned counsel and on perusal of the record, this Court is <i>prima facie</i> satisfied that the petitioner has shown sufficient cause for grant of interim order of <i>status quo</i> for a limited period. Accordingly, there shall be <i>status quo</i> with regard to closing of the existing 60 feet road by barbed wire fencing by the respondent authorities till 25.08.2022. Post on 25.08.2022. Vjl MGR,J	
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
