WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI.V.R.Reddy Kovvuri presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declare inaction on the part of the respondent No.2 in considering the Appeal/Revision filed by the petitioner through representations, dated 25.04.2005, 01.06.2005, 05.08.2005, 28..02.3006, 01.07.2006, 20.09.2015 and 29-02-2016 against the Order, dated 23.03.2005 in Rc.No.Bkg/Estt.AM.IV/SUSP/2003-2004, dated 23.03.2005 stopping three (3) Annual Grade Increments with cumulative effect and treating his suspension period as leave on loss of pay without assigning any reason whatsoever as arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the well established legal principles apart from being violative of the fundamental rights guaranteed to the petitioner under Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent No.2 to consider the Appeal/Revision filed by me through the representation, dated 25.04.2005, 01.06.2005, 05.08.2005, 28..02.3006, 01.07.2006, 20.09.2015 and 29-02-2016 by giving the an opportunity of hearing and grant annual grade increments for the years, 2004-2007 by setting aside the Order, dated 23.03.2005 in Rc.No.Bkg/Estt.AM.IV/SUSP/2003-2004, dated 23.03.2005.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri.V.R.Reddy Kovvuri Advocate for the Petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Cooperation for Respondent No.1, Ms.M.Siva Jyothi, learned Standing Counsel for Respondent Nos.2 & 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
