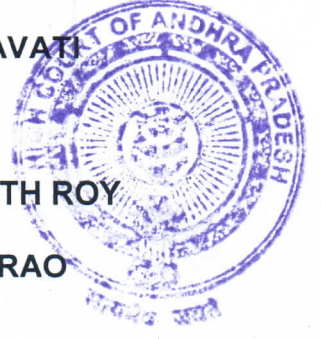

The Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed in support thereof and the Order of the High Court dated 01.08.2023 and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K.G.Krishna Murthy, Senior Counsel representing Sri Narasimha Reddy.G.L, Counsel for the appellant and of Sri G.V.V.S.R.Subramanyam, Counsel for Respondent Nos. 1 to 5, made the following

ORDER:

“Counter-affidavit not filed.

Time extended by four (4) weeks.

The petitioner has filed memo showing payment of fine of Rs.2,000/- as directed by this Court as per order, dated 01.08.2023. Therefore, the Interim order granted earlier is extended till the next date of hearing.
