Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased topleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly in the nature of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents in not releasing the Net Bill Amounts coming to Rs. 3,78,80,807- 00/- for the works executed by the Petitioner even though there is no dispute and the bills were approved long back, on the ground of lack of funds, as arbitrary, capricious, unjust, unfair, contrary to public policy, and illegal and consequently direct the Respondents to pay the said amount to the Petitioner forthwith along with interest @ 12percent p.a., from the date of approval of the bills till date of payment following the judgment of this Honble High Court in the case of Kathupalli Venkata Sowmya Vs. The State of Andhra Pradesh and ors., W.P. no. 2511 of 2021, dated 22-03-2022, and pass

The Court made the following order:

Aggrieved by the non-payment of bill amounts to the petitioner in relation to the completed works, the present writ petition is filed.

2. Heard Sri Abdul Rasheed, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Roads & Buildings Department. No representation for the petitioner.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader on counter submitted that, the authorities have admitted to pay the net amount to the petitioner after making statutory deductions and accordingly sought six(06) months time for such payment.

4. Taking into consideration the above submission, as the authorities are ready to pay the entitled net amount to the petitioner, this court is inclined to **dispose of** the writ petition, at the admission stage with the following direction:

The respondents are directed to release the legally admitted/entitled net amount to at the earliest, and at any rate, within a period of six(06) months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Accordingly, the writ petition is **disposed of**. No costs.

Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
