WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate SRI J RAVI KUMAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents more particularly the action of respondents herein in not disposing of our complaint dt. 06-05-2022 and not concluding the proceedings initiated pursuant to an endorsement dt. 30-05-2022 and taking appropriate action (including criminal prosecution) against the 5th respondent herein and his henchmen for playing fraud and against the officers concerned for dispensing with the procedure provided under law and acting as per their whims and fancies and abusing the powers vested with them for wrongful gain as illegal, high handed and violative of Articles 14, 21 & 300A of the Constitution of India and also violation of the provisions under A.P. Rights in land and Pattadar Passbook Act, 1971 86 Rules 1989 and consequently direct the 2nd respondent to conduct an enquiry on petitioners complaint dt. 06-05-2022 and take appropriate action against officers concerned and the 5th respondent for violating the law of the land and abusing the powers vested with them further directing the 4th respondent to restore petitioners names in the revenue records against their lands admeasuring Ac. 4.70 cents & Ac. 2.32 cents in Sy. No's. 2-1 & 2-5 respectively in Chintalagudem village as per our respective shares.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri J RAVI KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR REVENUE for respondent Nos.1 to 4,

directed issue of fresh notice to the Respondent No.5, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
