Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of 4th Respondent in issuing stringent Impugned Notice vide Rc A/449/2017 dt.02-11-2019, which was served on the petitioner on 07-11-2019 by strait away directing the petitioner to evict the land within 15 days baring an extent Ac.5.75 cents in Sy.Nos.980/P, 981/1P, 979/P, 980/P, 979/P and 980/P of Nuzvid, Nuzvid Mandal, Krishna District without conducting neither enquiry nor giving any opportunity of hearing or following due process of law is illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and also in violation of Artical 14, 15, 21 and 300 A of Constitution India. Consequently direct the Respondents not to dispossess the petitioner from his private land without following due process of law;

IA NO: 1 OF 2019:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 4th Respondent not to dispossess the .petitioner from his land an extent Ac.5.75 cents in Sy. Nos.980/P, 981/1P, 979/P, 980/P, 979/P and 980/P of Nuzvid, Nuzvid Mandal, Krishna District by suspending Impugned Notice vice Rc A/449/2017 dt. 02-11-2019 issued by the 4th Respondent, pending disposal of the WP 18161 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 15/11/2019, 27/12/2019 and 20-02-2020 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI N A RAMACHANDRA MURTHY Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondents, the Court made the following.
