Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction mostly one which is in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the Proceedings in File NO.REV02-MAGL0SARF/10/2024-MAGL 5 dated 02-06-2025 of the 3rd Respondent as illegal, irregular, arbitrary, unjustified, unconstitutional, unsustainable and contrary to the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 and the Rules framed thereunder and violative of Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently set-aside the same;

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings of the Respondents in pursuance of File No.REV02-MAGL0SARF/10/2024-MAGL 5 dated 02-06-2025 of the 3rd Respondent, pending disposal of WP No. 19464 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier order of the High Court dated 28.07.2025, 18.08.2025, 06.10.2025, 01.12.2025, 15.12.2025, 19.01.2026 & 22.04.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Cheruvu Chaitanya Bhargava Sarma, Advocate for the Petitioners, Sri Gudiseva Narasimha Rao, Central Government Counsel for the Respondent No.1, and of Sri Jagarlapudi Venkateswara Prasad, Advocate for Respondent No.2, learned GP for Revenue for the Respondent Nos.3 to 5, learned GP for Home for the Respondent No.6, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

Sri J.Venkateswara Prasad, learned counsel for the 2nd respondent not present. Counter on behalf of the 2nd respondent also not filed.

Sri P.Veera Reddy, learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner reported ready to proceed with the matter.

It is brought to the notice of this Court by the learned Senior counsel that the restoration petition also not disposed of in the Debt Recovery Tribunal (DRT) as directed by this Court on 28.07.2025.

In view of the above factual position, post the matter on 14.07.2026 for 'Orders'.
