WHEREAS the Petitioner has presented the above case under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971, through its counsel Sri P.Kamalakar, praying that this Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to punish the respondents herein for intentionally, deliberately, willfully violating the orders in W.P.No.1677 of 2023, dated 19.11.2024;

WHEREAS the said case coming on for orders as to admission on this day and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein and the earlier orders of the High Court dated 18.02.2026, 27.04.2026 & 16.06.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P.Kamalakar, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Sri Y.Somaraju, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.1, 2, 3, 5 & 7, and of Ms. Sultana Shaik, Advocate for the Respondent No.4, and of Sri R.Kalyan Chakravarthy, Advocate for the Respondent No.6, the Court made the following

ORDER:

"Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondents.

This Court on 16.06.2026 directed the Registry to issue Bailable Warrant against respondent No.4 for non appearance and non compliance of the conditional orders passed by this court on 27.04.2026.

Today, in compliance of the orders of this Court, the respondent No.4 appeared in person before this Court and furnished written instructions stating that the orders of this Court are complied with and the balance amount to be payable by the respondent No.4 is cleared on 14.07.2026.

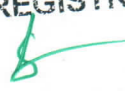
Registry also furnished a letter dated 13.07.2026 stating that the warrant was executed against the respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.4 also furnished a personal bond executed by the respondent No.4 to the Registry for a sum of Rs.10,000/- along with two sureties.
