Petition under Section 482 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Station House Officer of Pattabhipuram Police Station, Guntur District to release the petitioner/Accused No.1 to 5 on bail in the event of their arrest in connection with Cr.No. 553/2025 of Pattabhipuram Police Station, Guntur District;

The Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri D.Purna Chandra Reddy, Counsel for the Petitioners and Public Prosecutor for the Respondent, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

There are long-standing civil disputes pending between the petitioners and the de-facto complainant. The de-facto complainant and the accused are family members of one Rayapati Veeraiah.

Having regard to the entire gamut of the litigation that has been pending between the petitioners and the de-facto complainant for quite a long time, and considering the fact that petitioner No.2/Accused No.2 is aged about 80 years and petitioner No.3/Accused No.3 is aged about 71 years, the Investigating Officer is directed not to arrest the petitioners until the next date of hearing.

However, the petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer on 19.08.2026 at 10.00 a.m. and shall continue to appear before the Investigating Officer and cooperate with the investigation. The Investigating Officer is directed to proceed with the investigation in accordance with law.

The Registry is directed to verify and put up the implead petition filed by the de-facto complainant.
