ORDER:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.2 to 4.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner is directed to take out personal notice in respect of respondent No.2 and respondent Nos.3 and 4 being minors through natural guardian mother/respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Order dated 24.06.2025 passed in F.C.O.P.No.141 of 2022 by the Judge, Family Court-cum-V Additional District Judge, Tirupati, shall remain stayed, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) to the respondent No.2 and Rs.8,000/- (Rupees eight thousand only) each to respondent Nos.3 and 4 every month towards their monthly maintenance. Additionally, the petitioner shall deposit 20% of the arrears amount within a period of six months in equal instalments.
