Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the proceedings initiated by respondent Nos.3 and 4 in Case No. F. 104/2026, dated 13/07/2026 under the provisions of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and contrary to the law laid down by this Hon'ble Court, and consequently, set aside all further proceedings including any action seeking eviction of the Petitioner from the joint family residential house,

The 4th respondent-police are only directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner.
