**The Court made the following order:**

The above writ petition was filed to declare the action of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in issuing the proceedings *vide* efile.No.47711/2017-A5 dated 07.07.2017, reverting the petitioner to his original post of NMR Sweeper, as illegal and arbitrary.
