Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the impugned action of the respondents in issuing impugned Notification No.01/CGM(HR)/2010, dt. 5-1-2011, and supplementary Notification No.01/CGM(HR)/2011, dt.17-10-2011 for the post of Junior Plant Attendant by applying provision of A.P. Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order 1975(Presidential Order) and treating the petitioner as non-local to the generating stations preferred by the petitioner and thereby denying opportunity to participate in Trade Test held on 13-4-2013 as highly illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 14 and 16 of Constitution of India and to pass

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased direct the respondents to conduct Trade Test for the petitioner for the post of Junior Plant Attendant, notified vide Notification No.01/CGM(HR)/2010, dt.5-1-2011 and Supplementary Notification No.01/CGM(HR)/2011, dt. 17-10-2011 and consider the candidature of petitioner without reference to local/District status pending disposal of the above writ petition and to pass

The Court made the following:

ORDER:-

The Petitioner is challenging the notification dated 05.01.2011 and supplementary notification dated 17.10.2011 issued by the respondents, calling for appointment to the post of Junior Plant Attendant, whereby the petitioner was treated as non-local candidate which denied the opportunity of the petitioner to participate in the trade test held on 13.04.2013.

2. The recruitment in pursuance of the said modifications is over and no interim orders were passed when this writ petition was admitted. The writ petition was directed to be listed along with W.P.No.20261 of 2013 and batch. The batch of writ petitions was dismissed on 09.11.2018.

3. Considering the same and also considering that the recruitment in pursuance of the said notifications is complete, no further orders can be passed.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
