are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted, on or before 19.08.2026, on which date the case stands posted for hearing.

The Court made the following ORDER:

There is a delay of nearly five days in lodging the FIR. The Petitioner, a resident of the State of Telangana, has directly approached this Court without availing his remedy before the learned District Judge or the Jurisdictional Judge concerned.

The Petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer on 12.08.2026 at 10:00 A.M. and shall continue to appear before the Investigating Officer as and when required.

Issue notice to Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Post the matter on 19.08.2026.

Until the next date of hearing, the Investigating Officer is directed not to take coercive steps against the Petitioner.
