Despite availability of vacancies, his case has not been considered for regularization. Learned counsel has placed on record additional affidavit along with bunch of documents, which include the notification issued by the 2nd respondent Corporation for filling up of the posts including Junior Assistant posts and also availability of vacancies in the Corporation. By reference to the aforesaid documents, it is submitted that admittedly when there are vacancies, following the ratio laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Jaggo v. Union of India : (2024 SCC OnLine SC 3826) and Dharam Singh v. State of U.P. : (Judgment, dt.19.08.2025, in Civil Appeal No.8558 of 2018), petitioner is entitled for regularization. 2.
