The Court made the following:**::ORDER::**

The petitioners originally filed O.A.No.2238 of 2017 on the file of learned Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal, at Hyderabad (for short 'the Tribunal') to declare the action of the respondents in not considering their case for regularization of their services as per the orders of this Court and also G.O.Ms.No.143 dated 16.03.1984, on completion of five years of service, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. After the abolition of the Tribunal, the O.A. was transferred to High Court and the same is numbered as W.P.(APAT).No.983 of 2021.

3. Since there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners on 08.11.2023, 29.11.2023 and 06.02.2026. The writ petition was directed to be listed on 13.02.2026, under the caption "for dismissal". Even on 13.02.2026, there was no representation for the petitioners. To give one more opportunity, the writ petition was adjourned to today.

4. Even today, there is no representation for the petitioners. It seems the petitioners are not interested in prosecuting the writ petition.

5. Hence, this Writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. No costs.
