Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the Respondent No.1 in entertaining the Petition No. Senior Citizen Act/37/2025 filed by the Respondent No.3 for cancellation of the registered Document bearing No.819/1996 dated 02-05-1996, Document No.353/1996 dated 14-02-1996, Document No.532/1993 and

533/1993 and thereby issuing the Notice for conducting enquiry as arbitrary, illegal, beyond jurisdiction and contrary to Sec.23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 and consequently direct the Respondent No.1 to close the enquiry in pursuant to the Petition No.Senior Citizen Act/37/2025 made by the 3rd Respondent in the interest of justice;

IA NO: 1 OF 2025:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in pursuant to the Petition No.Senior Citizen Act/37/2025 made by the 3rd Respondent pending before the 1st Respondent, pending disposal of WP.No.20902 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition, coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court order dated 14.08.2025, 04.02.2026, 09.03.2026 & 20.04.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P.Nagendra Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioners and GP for Revenue for the Respondent No.1 and GP for Women and Child Department for the Respondent No.2, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

The Writ Petition is filed assailing the notice issued by the respondents, as it is contrary to the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007. It is known law that against the show cause notice, no Writ Petition is maintainable. Even assuming that the authority who issued notice having no jurisdiction, the same can be raised by offering an explanation. The petitioner has not submitted any explanation. Therefore, this Court is inclined to vacate the interim order granted on 14.08.2025.

Accordingly, the interim order granted on 14.08.2025 stands vacated and the petitioner is permitted to file an explanation to the notice issued by the respondents.

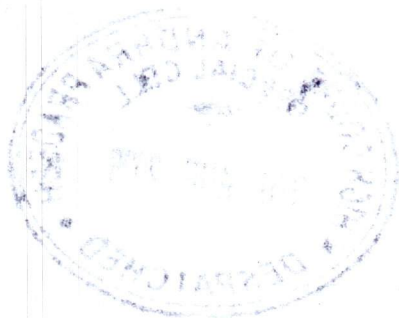
