The Court made the following Order :

This Criminal Petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., has been filed by the Petitioner/accused, to quash the proceedings in FIR No. 47 of 2021 of Sullurpet Police Station, SPSR Nellore District.

2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/ State. It is submitted by them that pursuant to registration of the aforesaid crime, police conducted investigation and filed Charge Sheet, which was taken on file as C.C.No.464 of 2021 on the file of the Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Sullurupeta, and the learned Magistrate, vide Judgment dated 11.12.2021 in the said C.C., acquitted the accused of the offences alleged, and in view of the same, nothing survives for adjudication in the present Criminal Petition, and the same has become *in fructuous*.
