ORDER:

Present writ petition came to be instituted aggrieved by the action respondents 1 and 2 in transferring the petitioner from aided junior college to unaided school, though under the same management, without securing prior permission from the competent authority, being illegal and arbitrary.

2. Though writ petition came to be instituted in the year 2006 and that by way of interim application, a prayer was made to repatriate

petitioner back to the junior college, the said prayer was not granted therein.

3. As petitioner was aged 50 years when the writ petition was instituted, as per learned counsel for the petitioner, he has already attained the age of superannuation.

4. In that view of the matter, this Court is of the opinion that no purpose would be served to go into the merits of the writ petition.

5. Accordingly, the writ petition stands closed. No order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending consideration, if any, in this case shall stand closed.
