WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri. RAYALCHERUVU ABISHEK REDDY, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring acts of respondent Nos.3 to 5 as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Art.19(1)(g) and 14, 16, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and also direct respondent No. 2 to 5 not to harass the Petitioners by calling and summoning the petitioners to the police station nor in any mode in connection with civil disputes between the petitioners and respondent Nos.6 to 8 and also direct respondent Nos.2 to 5 not to interfere in civil disputes between the petitioners and respondent Nos.6 to 8;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri RAYALCHERUVU ABISHEK REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioners and of GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos.1 to 5, directed issue of notice to Respondent Nos.6 to 8, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 151 CPC., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 2 to 5 not to interfere with the Petitioners day to day activity by calling or summoning them to the Tirupati Rural Police Station nor in any mode in connection with civil disputes between the petitioners and respondent Nos.6 to 8, pending disposal of Writ Petition.

**The Court made the following ORDER:**

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5.
3. Issue notice to respondent Nos.6 to 8.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.6 to 8 through Speed Post with acknowledgement due and file proof of service.

5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, and in view of the well-settled principle of law that the Police have neither the jurisdiction nor the authority to adjudicate, interfere with, or resolve disputes that are purely civil in nature, respondent-Police are hereby directed not to interfere with the civil disputes of the petitioners, without any legal cause.

6. List the matter on 01.09.2026 in the Adjourned Motion List.
