herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI N BHARAT BABU, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Sri L.V.S.Nagaraju, Advocate for Respondent No.1 and of Sri Gurram Rama Chandra Rao, Advocate for Respondent No.2, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Sri Gurram Rama Chandra Rao, learned counsel for the respondents submitted that, as per the directions of this court, new proposal has to be sent to the Accountant General by putting the petitioner’s date of birth as 10.10.1958 for payment of pension wherein the petitioner has to come and put his signature and immediately they will take steps.

Sri P.G.Naidu, learned senior counsel representing learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, a date may be given to the petitioner to appear before the authority for putting signatures.

In view of the above submissions, the petitioner is directed to visit the office of the concerned department on 24.06.2026 for signatures as required. On securing the required signatures, the respondent authorities shall immediately take steps for payment of pension in accordance with law.

The respondent nos.1 & 2 appeared before this court today.
