The Court made the following:

::ORDER::

The above writ petition was filed to declare the inaction of the respondents in conducting a survey and to demarcate the boundaries in respect of Sy.Nos.261/1, 6 & 7 in Ramanayyapeta Village, Kakinda Rural Mandal, East Godavari District, despite an application being made to the Collector Grievance Cell, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. Heard learned counsel appearing on both sides.

3. In the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, it was pleaded that the petitioner's grandfather purchased the property of an extent of Ac.2.04 cents in Sy.No.261/1 (Sub D 261/1, 6, 7) of Ramayyapeta Village, under a registered document dated 11.12.1926. Later, the petitioner's father inherited the property. The petitioner's father died on 20.10.1993. Thereafter, a partition was made among the sharers on 14.10.2018. The petitioner made an application to the Collector Grievance Cell, East Godavari, Kakinada. Respondent No.2, the Collector, directed Respondent No.4 to conduct a

survey and demarcate the boundaries. Respondent No.4 issued notice to the petitioner as well as the Endowment Surveyor to survey on 12.02.2019. Respondent No.4 visited the land on that day. Respondents 5 & 6 failed to submit the documents, and hence, no survey was conducted.

4. Pending the writ petition, the petitioner, along with others, filed W.P.No.24860 of 2022. A survey was conducted, and a report was filed. A copy of the survey report is available with the petitioner.

5. Given the facts and circumstances of the case and since the survey was conducted, the cause in the writ petition does not survive. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No order as to costs.

As a sequel, pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
