WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. D V SASIDHAR, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issuance of an appropriate Writ, Order, or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, by declaring the action of the Respondent No.2 to 4 officials in preventing the petitioner to be in service up to age of 62 years, even after 4th Respondent passing General Body resolution dated 30.09.2022 and Threemen Committee Resolution dated 29.07.2026 by increasing the age of retirement of petitioner from 60 to 62 years, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and contrary to the principles of natural justice, violative of Fundamental Rights guaranteed under Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and contrary to the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Cooperative Societies Act, 1964 and Rules made therein, consequently direct the respondents to continue the service of the petitioner till he attains the age of 62 years;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri D V SASIDHAR, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP FOR CO-OPERATION for the Respondent Nos.1 & 2 and of Sri. SRINIVAS BASAVA, STANDING COUNSEL for the Respondent No.3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to continue the services of the petitioner till he attains the age of 62 years in 4th Respondent society, pending disposal of the above Writ Petition;

The Court made the following ORDER:

- 1. Notice before admission.**
- 2. Learned Government Pleader for Co-operation takes notice for Respondent Nos. 1 and 2.**
- 3. Learned Standing Counsel for DCC Bank takes notice for the Respondent No.3.**
- 4. Issue notice to Respondent No. 4**
- 5. Learned counsel for the Petitioner is also permitted to take out personal notice to Respondent No. 4 by RPAD and file proof of service in the Registry.**
- 6. The present Writ Petition is filed questioning the action of the Respondents in not extending the benefit of enhanced age of superannuation from 60 to 62 years to the Petitioner pursuant to the resolutions of the Executive Committee as well as the General Body of the Respondent-Society and to declare the same as illegal and arbitrary.**
- 7. The learned Government Pleader submits that the Division Bench of this Court in W.A.No.649 of 2024 had passed an interim order on 11.09.2024 suspending the order of the learned Single Judge with regard to the same relief.**
- 8. Heard the respective counsel.**
- 9. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that though the Division Bench of this Court in W.A.649 of 2024 had stayed the enhancement of age of superannuation of 62 years, the distinguishable factor in this case is that the General Body as well as the Executive**

Committee of the Respondent-Society had resolved to enhance the age of its employees on par with the Government employees i.e., 62 years. Apart from that Rule 28(7) of the Andhra Pradesh Co-operative Societies Rules enables the Society to enhance the age of its employees on par with the Government employees. In W.A.No.649 of 2024, the interim orders were passed at the instance of the Co-operative Society which did not pass any General Body or Executive Committee resolution as done in this case.

10. In that view, there shall be interim order as under;

(i) The Respondents shall continue the Petitioner till he attains the age of 62 years pending further orders.

11. Post this case along with W.P.No.16226 of 2026.
