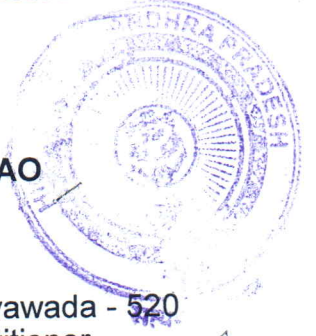

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus and A) Declare the actions of the respondents in making the petitioner to pre close the 017 Stall (SG1SMU017) for purpose of renewing 016 Stall (SG1SMU016) at Platform no. 6 of Vijayawada Railway Station in terms of commercial circular no. 22 of 2017 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, contrary to the Judgement dated 30.03.2022 of this Hon'ble Court in W.P.No. 2167 of 2022 and consequently, direct the Respondents to permit the petitioner to operate 017 Stall at Platform no. 6 of the Vijayawada Railway Station for the unexpired license period B) Declare the actions of the respondents in issuing Tender no Catg-03-2022-SG1SMU017 dated 29.07.2022 for 017 Stall before the expiry of the license period of 017 Stall as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and consequently direct the Respondents to withhold the above Tender till the expiry of the license period of 017 Stall.

IA NO: 1 OF 2022

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in Tender no: Catg-03-2022-SG1SMU017 dated 29.07.2022 pending the disposal of the writ petition 25580 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 2 OF 2022

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased permit the petitioner to operate 017 Stall at Platform no. 6 of the Vijayawada railway station for the unexpired license period Pending disposal of WP 25580 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.
