ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner brought to the notice of this Court that an execution petition has been filed against the judgment and decree passed by the 1st Appellate Court and that the trial Court is going to take up the execution proceedings.

Since the second appeal has been admitted, if the executing Court proceeds further, the purpose of filing the second appeal would be defeated.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and for the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, all further proceedings, including the execution of the decree and judgment passed in A.S. No. 66 of 1999 dated 06.07.2021, on the file of the V Additional District Judge, Allagadda, have been stayed till 06.03.2026.”

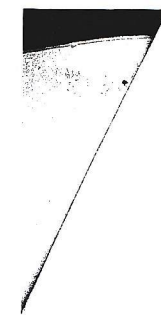
