The present writ petition is filed seeking following relief:

“....to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 2nd and 3rd respondents action in their proceedings dated 14.12.2001, 08.11.2002, 04.06.2004 and 01.02.2004 in respect of placing the petitioners as apprentice in SGT and School Assistants Aided Post and pass..”

2. Petitioners were initially appointed as Secondary Grade Teachers in unaided vacancy on different points of time. Later, they came to be absorbed in aided vacancies. However, they

were subjected to undergo apprenticeship in terms of G.O.Ms.No.100, Education (PS-I) Department, dated 16.08.2001.

3. Sri C. Sunil Kumar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioners, states that inasmuch as the petitioners were appointed much prior in time and have put in enough period of service in unaided post, anterior to issuance of G.O.Ms.No.100, Education (PS-I) Department, dated 16.08.2001, their cases would not fall within the preview of aforesaid G.O. and therefore stand excluded. In support of his contentions, reliance has been placed on the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.20119 of 2005.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader, appearing for the respondents, does not deny the said legal position and that very same issue has been considered in favour of the petitioner in W.P.No.20119 of 2005.

5. In view of the same, following the earlier order passed in W.P.No.20119 of 2005, the Writ Petition stands allowed. No order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending consideration, if any, in this case shall stand closed.
