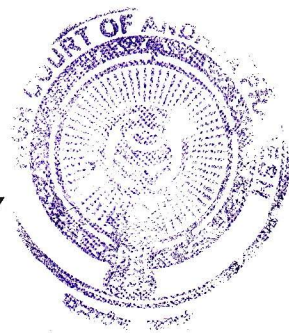

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to consider and grant extension of time for a further period of Three (03) months time for disposal of CC.No. 755/2016 on the file of Addl Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kanigiri FAC Prl. Civil Judge (Junior Division) Kandukur as directed by the Hon'ble High Court in CrI.P.No.

9384/2017, dated 08-09-2023, Pending disposal of CRLP No. 9384 of 2017, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case). The Court made the following

ORDER

“This Court, by order, dated 08.09.2023, directed the trial Court to proceed with the trial expeditiously and conclude the case on or before 30.10.2023. Thereafter, the said time was extended by another four (04) weeks by order, dated 29.11.2023 passed in I.A.No.1 of 2023. Again, the said time was extended by another three (03) months by order, dated 28.06.2024 in I.A.No.1 of 2024. Once again, the trial Court addressed a letter, dated 06.01.2025 to the Registry seeking extension of time. The said letter was placed as I.A.No.1 of 2025. In view of the reasons explained in the letter. I.A.No.1 of 2025 was ordered on 07.02.2025 by extending time by another three (03) months. Now, the trial Court addressed a letter, dated 23.07.2025 to the Registry seeking extension of time and the said letter is placed as I.A.No.2 of 2025.

2. This court perused the above said letter. In view of the reasons explained in the letter, this court is of the considered view that to meet the ends of justice, I.A.No.2 of 2025 can be disposed of by granting another three (03) more months of time from date of receipt of copy of this order to the trial Court to proceed with the trial and conclude the case.

3. Accordingly, this application is allowed and another three (03) more months time is granted from date of receipt of copy of this order to the trial Court to proceed with the trial and conclude the case. However,

it is made clear that no further extension will be granted under any circumstances."
