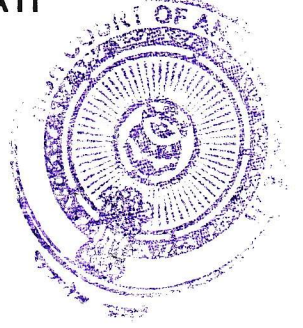

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records pertaining to the impugned G.O.Ms.No.105, Dt. 16.10.2024 issued by the 1st respondent and to declare the impugned G.O.Ms.No.105, Dt.16.10.2024 as illegal, arbitrary, and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently set aside the same.

Petition under Section 151 CPC., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 to furnish a copy of the sanction order vide G.O.Ms.No.105, Dt. 16.10.2024 issued by the 1st respondent to the petitioner, pending disposal of the writ petition.

MANOJ KUMAR BETHAPUDI, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP FOR SERVICES I, for the Respondent No.1 and of Sri. SYAM SUNDER RAO, STANDING COUNSEL for the Respondent No.2;

The Court made the following ORDER:

It is stated that in similar circumstances this Court passed an interim order of status quo for a limited period.

The same is not disputed by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I.

In that view, there shall be an interim order of status quo for a period of four (4) weeks.

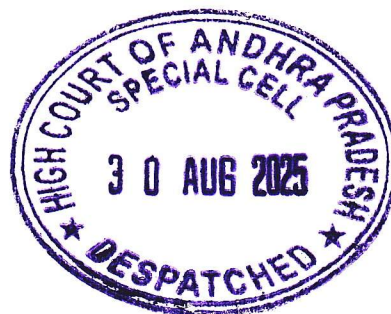
