

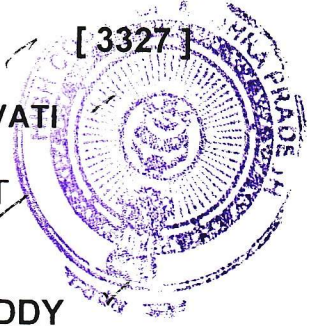

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri
HARANADHA RAJU KATTA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit
filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or

direction, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS, declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in not releasing the arrear bills of Rs.7,12,878/- (Rupees seven lakhs twelve thousand and eight hundred seventy eight only) as per proceedings R.C.No.1/UGC/PR/2019, dated 13-03-2019 and 06-06- 2019, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, discriminatory and violative of Art. 14 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents to release the sanctioned UGC 2016 RPS bills from 01-01-2016 to 30-09-2017 along with interest at the rate of 18 % per annum from the date of the sanction till realization.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri HARANADHA RAJU KATTA Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP FOR SCHOOL EDUCATION for Respondents 1 to 5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith(copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted within three weeks or to which date the case stands posted for hearing.

Issue notice to respondent No.6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.6 by registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service before the Registry within a period of three (3) weeks.

List the matter after three (3) weeks. "
