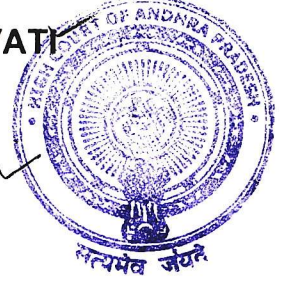

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ or direction more particularly a writ in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents not paying compensation to the 1st petitioner to an extent of Ac.0.60 cents in Sy.No.434/3 and Ac. 0.40 cents in Sy.No.485/3 and lands of the 2nd petitioner to an extent of Ac.1.02 cents in Sy.No.99/8, Ac. 1.50 cents in Sy.No.99/7 of Vikrutamala Village, Yerpedu Mandal, Tirupati District, as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 14, 21 & 300-A Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondents to pay compensation to the in respect of the lands of 1st

petitioner to an extent of Ac.0.60 cents in Sy.No.434/3 and Ac. 0.40 cents in Sy.No.485/3 and lands of the 2nd petitioner to an extent of Ac.1.02 cents in Sy.No.99/8, Ac. 1.50 cents in Sy.No.99/7 of Vikrutamala Village, Yerpedu Mandal, Tirupati District, accordance with the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Re-settlement Act, 2013;
