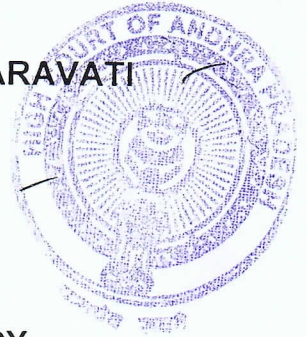

Petition under Section 389(1) of Cr.P.C. is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the execution of sentence dt. 21.10.2016 passed in S.C.No.184 of 2015 on the file of the IV Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Nellore and release the petitioner on bail, Pending disposal of CRLA 326 of 2017, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 1 OF 2022

Petition under Section 389(1) of Cr.P.C. is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the execution of sentence passed in S.C.No. 184 of 2015 on the file of IVth Additional District & Sessions Judge, Nellore, arising out of Crime No. 74 of 2015 of II Town Police Station, Nellore, Pending disposal of CRLA 326 of 2017, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the memorandum filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri G VIJAYA SARADHI Advocate for the Petitioner, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

“In compliance with the order of this Court dated 20-06-2025, the Secretary to Government, Health, Medical and Family Welfare Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh, has filed an Affidavit along with relevant material. This Court has noticed the contents of the affidavit and the material attached to it. Having noted the contents of paragraph Nos. 13 to 15 of the Affidavit dated 23-07-2025, it appears that the inquiry has been concluded against the Forensic Expert. Therefore, this inquiry is closed.

2. Insofar as the Affidavit filed by the Principal Secretary to Government, Home Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh, is concerned, this Court has perused the contents of the affidavit as well as the material documents filed along with it. At the outset, this Court is constrained to observe that this affidavit along with additional documents have been filed in a cavalier manner without even personally looking into the quality of the copies, wherein 50% of it are not even legible and readable. This Court is not convinced with the contents of the affidavit and the contents of the affidavit do not inspire confidence of this Court that there is reasonable progress in the working of the committees. In this view of the manner, we deem it appropriate to direct Dr. T.T.K.Reddy, Head of the Department, Forensic Medicine, Guntur Medical College, and also the Principal Secretary, Home Department, to appear before the Court on the next date of hearing to assist the Court in understanding the progress and the steps that are being taken in this inquiry.

3. Liberty to the Principal Secretary to Government, Home Department, to file a Better Affidavit.
